PAYING YOUR RENT




Introduction

By paying your rent you are making sure that you will continue to have a place to live with Langstane Housing Association. Rent also provides the income which is required to provide a range of services including repairing and maintaining your home.

How to pay

The Association accepts a variety of payment methods to allow you to pay your rent in a way convenient to you. If you wish to discuss the best way for you to pay rent, please contact us on 01224 423 000

Payment choices are as follows

Allpay

You can pay your rent at any Post Office or PayPoint outlet. To take advantage of this request a payment card from us.

Standing Order

You can set up a standing order so that your payment comes to us direct from your bank account on a regular basis.

Direct Debit

The quick and convenient way to pay your rent. Set it up once and then we do the rest. You will never forget to pay your rent again.

Telephone

You can pay over the phone by credit or debit card. All you need is your card details.

Cash / Cheque

We accept cash and cheques at our offices in Aberdeen and Elgin. Alternatively, you can post us a cheque to Freepost RUBX-GKUH-XYHZ, Langstane Housing Association Ltd, 680 King Street, Aberdeen, AB24 1ZQ

Online

Pay online at <u>www.allpay.net</u> You will need your rent payment card reference number which is on your Allpay card.

Recurring Card Payment

An automatic debit card payment agreed by you for a recurring date and time that suits. This can easily be amended for any change of circumstances and you will also receive text/e-mail payment confirmation.



Claiming Benefit

The Association also offers free benefit checks to all tenants with our Tenant Welfare Advisor who is available for an appointment including home visits. Our Tenant Welfare Advisor can also help you make a claim for benefits including Housing Benefit or Universal Credit to help you pay your rent.
